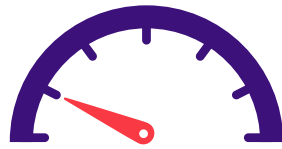

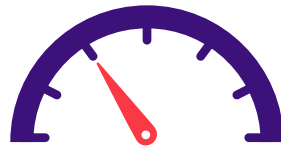

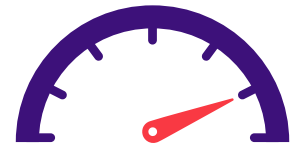

¹ This is the minimum download speed you can expect during busy periods (7pm-11pm) on nbn12 and nbn25.

² NBN Fixed Wireless Plus is a 'best efforts' service and is delivered without a typical evening peak guarantee. The service is expected to achieve the potential of 25 Mbps at least once in a 24 hour period. NBN FW Plus has a theoretical maximum speed of 75/10 Mbps.

Fixed Wireless speeds may be significantly impacted by congestion. Actual speeds to be confirmed after activation. If your service cannot provide the speed tier of your plan and this cannot be fixed, you can move to a lower speed plan or exit your plan at no cost.

Notes

Technical Limitations

- Your nbn service will not work during power failures. This service does not include a battery backup power supply for nbn supplied equipment or customer equipment. During a power outage your VoIP phone will not function, including calls to emergency services.
- Your speed or performance may be reduced by a range of other factors such as your router, internal house wiring and wifi interference. Talk to us about what may be causing your slow speeds and we can suggest ways to improve the speed or performance.
- Fixed wireless services may be subject to performance limitations due to the distance or line of sight to the tower or other factors that cannot be fixed. In some circumstances, these impacts may be so great that typical plan speed information would not be an accurate representation of the speeds that could be expected on the service at any time of the day. Services experiencing high latency may have issues with VoIP services and gaming.

Medical Alarms / Security

Before acquiring an nbn service, you should find out if any medical or security alarm services you want to use are compatible with an nbn service. If any such services are not compatible, you should check with the provider to see what alternatives are available.
